Home-Based RTC

The St. Vincent's Villa Residential Treatment Center (RTC) is excited to offer an innovative short-term home-based program.

The home-based RTC program is designed to reduce lengths of stay in higher end care, expand community resource integration, preserve family connectedness and achieve more positive long-term outcomes for children and families.

Boys and girls within this program will spend five days a week in residential care at St. Vincent's Villa and two days a week in their homes. While at home, St. Vincent's Villa will provide comprehensive clinical services for the child and family, while preserving and expanding community supports.

Services Provided

Some of the services provided by our homebased RTC program include:

- Individualized treatment planning, including individual, family and group therapy
- In-home services and supports
- Family support groups
- Family resources and education
- Coordination of after-care services
- Case management/advocacy services and coordination with schools and other community-based resources
- Psychiatric evaluation and treatment
- Medication management
- Nursing and routine health care
- Level V non-public school
- Behavioral support and management
- Spiritual and moral development
- Volunteer services including a mentoring program
- Structured therapeutic recreational and activity programming
- Therapeutic, trauma-informed living environment focused on the areas of problem solving, coping, social skills development and life skills training.
